#### **Tuition Project - high school students....**



Villa 16 and Mwatate are both located in the remote regions of Kenya. It is 3 hours driving from Mombasa to reach these 2 orphanages.

In order for the high school students to receive their secondary education, they must attend boarding schools.

There are 8 children attending boarding school at the moment. The cost per student, per semester, is approx \$325.

Without donations from well wishers, these children will not get their high school education. nor the opportunity to realize their dreams.



## Tumaini Joseph, who lives at Mwatate, is one of the success stories.

Tumaini has just graduated from Kenyatta High School.

This is the same boarding school that Dr Kireti at-tended.


